Miracles at 33,000 feet

As I travel through China I enjoy seeing the hand of the Lord at work not only in the meetings, but in the everyday activities of travel. I find that my steps and my airline seats are ordered by the Lord. Here is a recent example.

After weeks of ministry in China I boarded a final flight to Beijing to catch my international flight home. **Since I no longer had a translator with me I assumed that I was finished with my mission and could sit and read.** But God has adventures awaiting missionary evangelists that have faithful praying supporters!

My seat number was 3D. **To my surprise I was seated with a group of 10 Chinese high school students going on a friendship tour to Japan.** The two students in my row were two English speaking 17 year olds, Linda and Lindsay. Both were excited to sit next to an American; and so the conversation began. **Before long I was presenting the gospel** the best I could considering the cultural and language barriers.

I had no more Chinese literature with me and needed to show them some scriptures. Behind me in seat 4D was a Chinese woman (Maggie). She whispers in my ear that she heard me mention Jesus and that she was also a believer. She said she spotted me in the airport terminal and knew immediately that I was a Christian. **She just happened to be reading her bible!** I turned to her and asked her to point out the scriptures to me to show the girls. Immediately we began working like an experienced team; both of us moving with the Holy Spirit. **It was anointed!** In this way we led the candidates right down the Romans Road of salvation.

I was amazed at how quickly and clearly they grasped the concepts. Both of the girls prayed with me to receive Jesus and after a little private discussion among themselves bowed their heads to pray some more! **They were amazed how God in His love for them had arranged two Christians from different sides of the world to work together to lead them to the truth.**

That's when I traded seats with Maggie and let her finish with the follow up, answering their questions and expanding their understanding. **It was a miracle at 33,000 feet.** All of us were blessed with how God can arrange an encounter and supply what is necessary to get a job done.

Perhaps we should all be praying for such daily encounters and remember that the mission is not over till the final trumpet sounds.
