CHINA NEWS

One of our goals in the coming year is to accelerate our church planting efforts in two provinces.

Evangelism teams are now going weekly into the unreached areas. A few churches have already been planted but hundreds more are needed.

The need for tracts and literature for these outreaches is greater than what we can safely smuggle.

Around the time of the Olympics, national security was at a heightened level throughout China. During this time, **I was detained 6 hours by the police, for our illegal religious activities.** This was not the first time we had been questioned but it was the longest. But I found favor in their eyes and spent much time sharing my faith and testimony with the 15 police and Government officials who had converged on our lodging.

They unfortunate result of the encounter was that all the literature we brought into the country for these outreaches was confiscated.

We are in the process of purchasing the necessary equipment to begin secretly producing tracts and literature inside China.

This will be a more secure and much less expensive way than attempting to meet this need through couriers.

Please pray for our continued success and safety as we move forward with the gospel. Many have not yet heard the story we have to tell.

Our mission is empowerment. First, we will minister the baptism in the Holy Spirit, then we will bring a training seminar in spiritual gift activations .

This type of seminar is always powerful because the attendees must engage in ministering to one another. This lends to a lot of personal ministry and provides a huge amount of encouragement for these pastors.

I am traveling with long time friend and colleague missionary Jerry Morris. **We are expecting lots of miracles, blessing, impartation, tears and laughter as the Holy Spirit is loosed afresh in their lives.**
