What began as an exhortation to our FaceBook friends. quickly turned into relief ministry this month. Friday before Easter, night numerous requests for help were coming from our friends and partners in India, Pakistan, Philippines, Thailand, Africa and Brazil. The churches needed help for their churches and

communities that were suffering. Our checking account was already low from providing funds, so my heart was sad that I had no more to send.

I shared my burden on FaceBook and exhorted my friends to remember that while our cupboards were full, there were less fortunate people around the world. I encouraged the Christian community to support any relief ministries they know. Little did I know what might develop.

In just 24 hours thousands of dollars began pouring in through Pal Pal and FaceBook and has continued all month. The response was sufficient to meet those needs and much more.





In just a few weeks, we have been able to aid missionaries in the Amazon, care for orphan children in Uganda and help churches in India, Pakistan, Philippines and Thailand provide needed food to their communities.

In the Philippines we have partnered with our friends to purchase <u>\$20</u> sacks of rice to provide for a mountain community of 350 families. Church workers in all these nations have been distributing the food and praying with each family. I



In Thailand, we are helping thousand of Filipinos who have been stranded without work or flights back to Manila.

**In India**, we are providing groceries bags for homes containing rice, oil, lentils, eggs and other needful things. <u>\$10 a bag</u> is such a small price to pay.

**In Mindanao, 22 pastors** who were struggling to supply for their families and churches have received ample help.

Our sadness turned to joy over the the Easter holiday. Thank you Lifeline supporters and ministry partners
