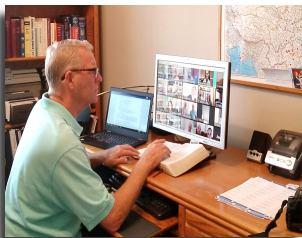


New Days...New Ways...



The recent months of pandemic precautions and restrictions have forced us to change some of our methods in continuing the work of Lifeline International.

Everyday we are depending more on social media and Internet services for correspondence, board meetings, discipleship teaching, financial transactions and video conferencing.



Our overseas networks have requested that we continue to engage their leaders with Zoom video sessions. **These group video sessions can be a bit more challenging when doing them internationally.** Some of our ministry associates are 12 time zones away in Asia, so our mornings and evenings have become important times to communicate with them. Additionally, Internet speeds in other countries can be poor and leader's home environments can come with barking dogs, crowing roosters and active children home from school.



Susan's church work has also required her to make the same changes as she works with ministry network leaders, local staff and leading small groups.

The world has suddenly changed and we must stay in step with the new challenges that it presents. **To this end, a new website is now being constructed to accommodate the changes we are making in online communications.** The site will be more interactive with videos, up-to date news and additional methods for giving. COVID-19 RELIEF CONTINUES



We continue to receive calls for help from our contacts who are suffering because of the Covid-19 pandemic. Many cannot work and are restricted to their homes. **Many third world governments are not able to bring any necessary aid to their population, so the crisis has created an opportunity for the local churches to fill in the gap.**

Lifeline partners are supplying funds to help our overseas family of believers and assist them in their outreach to their communities.



Last month, we supplied food for dozens of communities in 8 nations through established relationships we know and trust. They have activated their church members to prepare and distribute food and supplies to their areas.
