This month, tube wells were drilled for the villages of Kalavagattunagar and Z.Ragampeta. These small communities are now enjoying access to clean water. These wells were provided by supporters of Lifeline International. Thank you. You have a done a

Several nations are experiencing second waves of the Covid-19 virus and many restrictions are still in place. CHINA has virtually no cases, but has imposed restrictions for US visitors. Inbound passengers may be required to quarantine upon arrival and install location-tracking

software on their phones in order to access public spaces and businesses. **Austria** is not receiving US citizens at this time.

Regardless of these circumstances, we are pressing forward and have travel planned for the **Philippines**, **China and Brazil in 2021 and 2022.** Until then, we will continue to empower our ministry outposts in these nations. We are happy to hear their reports and shall join them soon.

## **India Crisis**

Regarding the virus pandemic, India had it's worst month in May with as many as 414,618 cases reported in just one day. Hundreds of thousands have lost their lives.

Our ministry friends report that 350 pastors have died from the Covid -19 virus in their state alone. One pastor had to bury 14 church members who died of Covid-19. He was also infected and is now recovering. They requested our prayer for the communities and assistance for the pastors who have no means to support themselves during this crisis.

We were very pleased to see several of our friends respond by giving donations to help. These funds were sent to two locations that have been assisting over 100 of their pastors. The widows and families of the pastors who died are also receiving help.



Other gifts this month, went to <u>Ghana for the</u> <u>purchase of a generator for a children's home</u>, <u>crisis relief for children in Uganda and missionary</u> <u>support for workers in China, Philippines, and India</u>.

## The apostle Paul commended the sacrificial giving of the believers in Macedonia writing:

"They begged us again and again for the gracious privilege of sharing in the gift for the Christians in Jerusalem. Though they have been going through much trouble and hard times, their wonderful joy and deep poverty have overflowed in rich generosity" II Corinthians 8:2 NLT.
